## **Objective**

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to identify different sea creatures, understand basic concepts related to the ocean, and express creativity through art and music.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Coloring materials
- Blank paper
- Toy sea creatures
- Music player
- Water-themed stickers
- Prepare a playlist of ocean-themed songs

## **Activities**

- **Art:** Let the student color sea creatures on paper and decorate them with water-themed stickers.
- **English:** Read a story about undersea adventures and ask the student to point out different sea creatures in the book.
- Math: Count the number of sea creatures the student colored and identify the colors used.
- **Music:** Play ocean-themed songs and encourage the student to move like different sea creatures.
- Science: Talk about where sea creatures live, what they eat, and how they move in the water.

## **Talking Points**

- Sea Creatures: "Look at this colorful fish! Can you name other sea creatures you see in the ocean?"
- Ocean Concepts: "The ocean is a big, big place with lots of water. Sea creatures like to swim and play in the ocean."
- **Creativity:** "It's fun to use different colors to make our sea creatures look pretty. What colors do you like?"
- Music and Movement: "Let's dance like a happy dolphin! Can you show me how dolphins move in the water?"
- Learning About Sea Creatures: "Sea creatures live in the water and some eat plants while others eat small fish. They are all special in their own way."
