

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to create and use flash cards of U.S. presidents for memorization and learning purposes.

Materials and Prep

- Blank index cards
- Pen or marker
- List of U.S. presidents
- Prior knowledge of U.S. presidents and their terms in office

Activities

- **Research and Write:** Research each U.S. president and write their name and term in office on one side of an index card.
- **Decorate:** Use colors and drawings to decorate the other side of the index cards to make the flash cards visually appealing.
- **Quiz Yourself:** Shuffle the flash cards and quiz yourself on the names and terms of the U.S. presidents. Keep practicing until you can recall all of them.

Talking Points
