Objective

By the end of this lesson, Audrey will be able to form legible joined letters to improve her handwriting fluency.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Pencil or Pen
- Printed Handwriting Worksheets

Activities

- Warm-up with Finger Tracing: Start by tracing letters in the air with your finger to warm up your hand muscles.
- **Handwriting Worksheets:** Practice forming joined letters on printed worksheets. Focus on smooth transitions between letters.
- **Word Building:** Write simple words using the joined letters you have learned. Practice spelling and writing fluently.

Talking Points

- Letters are like puzzle pieces: "Think of each letter as a puzzle piece that fits together to create words."
- **Smooth transitions are important:** "Try to make the transitions between letters smooth like a flowing river."
- Practice makes perfect: "The more you practice, the better your handwriting will become."
