Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to express their thoughts and feelings about the Skibidi phenomenon using descriptive language, while also enhancing their vocabulary and writing skills through engaging activities.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Pencil or pen
- Access to a device to watch Skibidi videos (optional)
- Imagination and creativity!

Before the lesson, it would be helpful to have a brief discussion about what Skibidi is, including its characters and themes, to ensure the student feels comfortable with the topic.

Activities

• Skibidi Character Sketch

The student will choose their favorite Skibidi character and draw a sketch. They will then write a short paragraph describing the character's personality, appearance, and any funny traits they have.

• Skibidi Story Creation

The student will create a short story featuring their chosen Skibidi character. They should include a beginning, middle, and end, using descriptive language to make the story exciting.

• Skibidi Dance Challenge

The student will learn a simple Skibidi dance move and then write a set of instructions on how to do it. This will help them practice writing clear and concise directions.

• Skibidi Vocabulary Game

The student will come up with a list of new words they learned from the Skibidi videos. They will then create their own definitions and use each word in a sentence.

Talking Points

- "What do you like most about Skibidi? Is it the characters, the music, or the dances?"
- "Can you tell me about your favorite Skibidi character? What makes them special?"
- "How do you think the Skibidi dance moves make people feel when they watch them?"
- "What kind of story would you create if you could be a part of the Skibidi world?"
- "Why do you think Skibidi has become so popular? What do you think people enjoy about it?"
- "How can we use our imagination to create new adventures for Skibidi characters?"
- "What new words did you learn from watching Skibidi? Can you use them in sentences?"
- "What do you think makes a good story? How can we apply that to our Skibidi story?"
- "How does dancing help express emotions? Can you show me your favorite Skibidi dance move?"
- "What lesson can we learn from Skibidi? Is there a message that stands out to you?"
