Objective

By the end of this lesson, Gabriella will have a comprehensive understanding of Mexico's geography, history, culture, and influence on literature. She will explore the major landforms, water bodies, and historical influences that shape Mexico today, and learn about its national identity through art, music, and cuisine.

Materials and Prep

- Map of Mexico (printed or drawn)
- Notebook and colored pencils or markers
- Access to a cooking area for preparing national dishes
- Information on the Maya, Aztec, and Spanish explorers (printed or summarized)
- Recipes for traditional Mexican dishes
- Art supplies (paper, paints, etc.) for creating a flag and coat of arms)

Activities

• Map Exploration:

Gabriella will create her own map of Mexico, marking its states, major rivers, volcanoes, and surrounding water bodies. This will help her visualize the geography of Mexico.

• Cultural Cooking:

Prepare a traditional Mexican dish together, such as tacos or enchiladas. This hands-on activity will allow Gabriella to experience Mexican culture through its cuisine.

• Art Creation:

Gabriella will design her own version of the Mexican national flag and coat of arms using art supplies. This will help her understand the symbols and colors that represent Mexico.

• Literature and History Discussion:

Read excerpts from works influenced by the Maya and Aztec civilizations, discussing how their stories and histories have shaped modern Mexican literature.

• Music and Dance:

Listen to traditional Mexican music and learn a simple dance. This will give Gabriella insight into the cultural expressions of Mexico.

Talking Points

- **Geography:** "Mexico is located in North America and is bordered by the United States to the north and Belize and Guatemala to the southeast."
- **Landforms:** "Mexico has many different landforms, including mountains, deserts, and coastal plains. The Sierra Madre mountains are some of the most famous!"
- **Rivers:** "The Rio Grande is an important river that forms part of the border with the United States."
- **Volcanoes:** "Did you know Mexico has more than 40 volcanoes? Some are still active!"
- **Official Language:** "The official language of Mexico is Spanish, which is spoken by the majority of the population."

Influence of National Dishes: The Maya and Aztec civilizations have greatly influenced Mexican
