Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will have a deeper understanding of fashion design principles, trends, and how to create a simple fashion sketch. The student will also explore their personal style and learn how to express it through clothing choices.

Materials and Prep

- Pencil and eraser

• Personal Style Reflection

The student will write a short reflection on their personal style, including what influences their choices and how they can incorporate trends into their wardrobe. This helps in building self-awareness and understanding the relationship between personal identity and fashion.

Talking Points

- "Fashion is not just about clothes; it's a way to express who you are without saying a word." Discuss how personal style reflects individuality.
- "Trends come and go, but your personal style is what makes you unique." Encourage the student to find a balance between trends and personal expression.

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- "The best designers are those who understand the history of fashion." Talk about how knowing past trends can influence current designs.
- "Sketching is a way to bring your ideas to life." Emphasize the importance of sketching in the fashion design process.
- "Inspiration can come from anywhere; keep your eyes open!" Remind the student to look for inspiration in everyday life, not just in fashion magazines.
