

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will learn about colors and shapes through fun activities that engage their creativity and critical thinking skills.

Materials and Prep

For this lesson, you will need:

- Colored paper or crayons
- Shapes cut out from paper (circle, square, triangle, etc.)
- A flat surface to work on

Before starting, make sure you have a clean workspace and all materials ready to go!

Activities

- **Color Hunt:** Go on a color hunt around the house! Ask the student to find objects of different colors and bring them back to the table. This will help them identify and name colors.
- **Shape Matching:** Use the shapes cut out from paper and ask the student to match them with objects around the house. For example, a round ball for a circle or a book for a rectangle.
- **Art Time:** Let the student create their own masterpiece using the colored paper or crayons. Encourage them to use different colors and shapes in their artwork!

Talking Points

- "What color is this? Can you find something else that is the same color?"
- "Can you tell me the name of this shape? How many sides does it have?"
- "What happens when we mix two colors together? Let's try!"
- "Can you draw a picture using three different shapes? What shapes will you use?"
