

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will understand the basic principles of interior design, including color theory, space planning, and the importance of personal style. The student will create a simple room design concept using these principles.

## Materials and Prep

- Paper and colored pencils or markers
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Magazines or printed images of furniture and decor (optional)

## Talking Points

- "Lighting is crucial in interior design. It can highlight features of a room or create a cozy atmosphere. How can you use light to enhance your design?"
- "Design is about problem-solving. If something doesn't work, don't be afraid to try something new. What challenges do you think you might face in your design?"
- "Remember, there are no strict rules in design—only guidelines. Feel free to experiment and make it your own!"
