

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to recognize and pronounce phonics sounds while engaging in fun Minecraft-themed activities. They will also enhance their reading skills through creative storytelling and vocabulary building related to the game.

## Materials and Prep

- Pencil and paper for writing
- Access to Minecraft (if applicable for creating a story setting)
- List of phonics sounds (e.g., short and long vowels, consonant blends)
- Printed or written Minecraft-themed vocabulary words
- Timer (optional for timed activities)

Before the lesson, familiarize yourself with basic phonics sounds and have a list of Minecraft-related vocabulary words ready, such as "creeper," "block," "craft," and "build." This will help in creating connections between phonics and the student's interests.

## Activities

- **Read Aloud Session:**

## Talking Points

- "Phonics helps us understand how letters and sounds work together to form words. Can you think of a Minecraft word that uses the sound 'C'?"
- "When we create stories, we use our imagination just like in Minecraft. What adventure will your character go on?"
- "Flashcards are a fun way to learn new words! Can you sound out this word for me?"
- "Reading aloud helps us practice our pronunciation. Let's take turns reading this Minecraft story together!"
