Objective

Materials and Prep

Activities

• Dinosaur Dance Party:

Play some fun music and have a dance party! Pretend to be different dinosaurs while dancing. Can you stomp like a T-Rex? Wiggle like a Triceratops?

• Dinosaur Roar:

Practice making dinosaur sounds! Take turns roaring like different dinosaurs. Can you make a loud roar or a quiet one?

• Dinosaur Parade:

Go on a dinosaur parade around the house or yard. Pretend to be dinosaurs walking together. What kind of dinosaurs are you?

• Dinosaur Story Time:

Make up a story about dinosaurs. Use your imagination to create a fun adventure. What do the dinosaurs do in your story?

Talking Points

- "Look at this big dinosaur! This is a T-Rex. Can you roar like a T-Rex?"
- "Dinosaurs lived a long, long time ago. Can you pretend to be a dinosaur?"
- "Some dinosaurs were very big, and some were small. What kind of dinosaur do you want to be?"
- "Dinosaurs had different colors! What color do you think your dinosaur is?"
