

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to plan a simple orchard layout, understand the requirements for growing different types of fruit trees, and appreciate the importance of biodiversity in an orchard ecosystem.

Materials and Prep

- Notebook and pencil for taking notes and sketching
- Access to the internet (optional) for research
- Basic understanding of plant growth and seasons
- Knowledge of local climate and soil conditions (if applicable)

Activities
