

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have created your own unique warrior cat character or crafted a story about your favorite warrior cat. You will explore your creativity through writing or physical crafting, enhancing your storytelling and artistic skills.

Materials and Prep

- Clay (any color)
- Paper and writing tools (pencils, pens, markers)
- Access to the Warrior Cats book series (if needed for reference)
- A comfortable workspace for crafting or writing

Before starting, think about your favorite traits of warrior cats. Consider what makes them special and how you can incorporate those traits into your own character or story.

Activities

- **Create Your Own Warrior Cat:**

Using clay, mold your own warrior cat character. Think about their name, personality, and special traits. Once you finish, share your creation with someone and explain your character's backstory.

- **Write a Short Story:**

Choose your favorite warrior cat character and write a short story about them. You can explore their adventures, challenges, or a day in their life. Make sure to include dialogue and descriptive details!

- **Character Profile:**

Create a character profile for your warrior cat. Include their name, age, clan, special abilities, and a brief history. This will help you develop a deeper understanding of your character.

Talking Points
