Objective

By the end of this lesson, Ella will have a deeper understanding of the themes and character development in "The Sixth Sense." She will also explore the elements of suspense and how they contribute to storytelling in films.

Materials and Prep

- Notebook and pen for notes and reflections
- Access to a comfortable viewing area (if watching the movie)
- Time for discussion and activities
- Knowledge of the basic plot of "The Sixth Sense"

Activities

• Character Analysis:

Ella will choose a character from the movie and write a short description of their personality, motivations, and how they change throughout the story. This will help her understand character development.

• Theme Exploration:

Ella will identify the main themes of the film, such as fear, acceptance, and the importance of communication. She can create a mind map to visualize how these themes are presented in the story.

• Suspense Creation:

Ella will write a short suspenseful scene inspired by "The Sixth Sense." She can focus on building tension and using descriptive language to create a spooky atmosphere.

• Discussion Time:

Talking Points
