Today we completed a worksheet named Counting Fingers. Children where asked to count the fingers on the hands in each box and circle the correct answer from the 3 options given. The instructions were given in both english and spanish and we verbally counted from 1-10 in spanish. for additional practice we also had some cards with hand pictures showing different numbers and the children were asked count the fingers and then place a clothing pin on the correct answer. By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to count fingers from 1 to 10 in both English and Spanish, recognize the correct number of fingers shown in pictures, and demonstrate understanding by circling the correct answer and using clothespins for counting practice.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Counting Fingers worksheet with pictures of hands
- Clothespins
- Markers or crayons
- Cards with hand pictures showing different numbers of fingers
- Knowledge of basic counting in English and Spanish (1-10)

## **Activities**

- **Counting Fingers Worksheet:** The student will complete the Counting Fingers worksheet by counting the fingers on the hands shown in each box and circling the correct answer from three options. This reinforces counting skills and recognition of numbers in both languages.
- **Clothespin Counting Game:** Using the hand picture cards, the student will count the fingers shown and place a clothespin on the correct number. This hands-on activity makes counting fun and interactive!
- **Spanish Counting Practice:** The student will practice counting from 1 to 10 in Spanish. This can be done together, with the teacher counting aloud, and the student repeating after them. This helps with language acquisition and reinforces numbers.

## **Talking Points**

- "How many fingers do you see? Let's count them together!"
- "In Spanish, we say 'uno' for one, 'dos' for two, and 'tres' for three. Can you say them with me?"
- "Great job! Now, can you circle the right number of fingers on your worksheet?"
- "Let's practice counting again! How many fingers are on this card?"
- "Using the clothespin is fun! Can you find the right number and clip it?"
- "Remember, counting is fun! We can count everything around us!"
- "In math, we use numbers to show how many. Can you show me how many fingers you have?"
