Objective

Materials and Prep

Talking Points

- "Some signs warn us about dangers, like curves or pedestrian crossings. What could happen if we ignore these signs?"
- "Let's think about how we can create our own signs. What message would you want to communicate to drivers?"
- "Remember, understanding traffic signs helps us make better decisions when we're on the road. Why do you think it's important for everyone to know these signs?"
