# Welcome Young Wizard! Reading Adventures in the World of Harry Potter

#### **Example Words to Look For:**

- Sorcerer
- Transfiguration
- Potions
- Quidditch
- Forbidden

#### 4. Wizarding World Discussion (15 mins)

Let's talk about what you read! Answer these questions in your notebook or discuss them aloud:

- Who are the main characters in this section? Describe one of them.
- Where does this part of the story take place?
- What important events happened?
- What challenges did the characters face? How did they react?
- What is one theme (like friendship, courage, mystery) you noticed?
- What do you predict will happen next? Why?

#### 5. Quick Quill Challenge (Summarization) (10 mins)

In your own words, write a short summary (3-5 sentences) of the chapter or section you read today. Focus on the most important parts.

# 6. Creative Corner (Optional Extension)

Imagine you received your letter to Hogwarts! Write a short paragraph describing your feelings and what you're most excited about learning.
