## **Objective**

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to write a short story based on an episode of Dora the Explorer.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Paper
- Pencils or crayons
- Access to an episode of Dora the Explorer

No additional preparation required.

## **Activities**

- 1. Watch an episode of Dora the Explorer with the student.
- 2. Discuss the main characters, setting, and plot of the episode.
- 3. Ask the student to choose their favorite part of the episode.
- 4. Encourage the student to think about what they would do if they were in Dora's shoes.
- 5. Guide the student to write a short story based on their chosen favorite part, using their imagination to continue the adventure.
- 6. Allow the student to illustrate their story.
- 7. Review the story together, helping the student with spelling and grammar if needed.

## First Grade Talking Points

- "Who is your favorite character in Dora the Explorer? Why do you like them?"
- "Where does Dora usually go on her adventures?"
- "What happened in the episode we watched today?"
- "If you were in Dora's shoes, what would you do in that situation?"
- "Can you tell me a story about what happens after the episode ends? Use your imagination!"
- "What do you think will happen in the next episode of Dora the Explorer?"
