Activity 2: Step into Their Shoes - Character Writing

Now it's time to get really creative and show your understanding of the characters!

Your Task: Choose **one** character from 'Waitress' (like Jenna, Dawn, Becky, Dr. Pomatter, Joe, Cal, Earl, or even Lulu!). Write a short monologue OR a diary entry from their perspective.

- A **monologue** is when a character speaks their thoughts aloud, perhaps to themselves or directly to an audience/another character who isn't speaking back.
- A diary entry is a character writing down their private thoughts and feelings, as if in a journal.

Think about:

- What are their hopes, fears, or dreams?
- What challenges are they facing?
- Try to use language and a tone that you think fits the character.
