Mamma Mia! Here We Go... Exploring the Geography of Greece!

Lesson Activities:

Introduction: Welcome to Kalokairi! (10 mins)

Do you remember the beautiful island setting in Mamma Mia? Crystal clear blue water, charming villages, sunny skies? While the island name 'Kalokairi' is fictional, the stunning scenery is very real! It's Greece! Today, we'll use the movie as our inspiration to explore the fascinating geography of Greece.

Think about it: What geographical features stood out to you in the movie? (Beaches, cliffs, hills, the sea?)

Activity 1: Placing Greece on the Map (15 mins)

Let's become geográfica explorers! Using an online map tool (like Google Maps) or a physical map:

- 1. Find Greece in Southern Europe. Which continent is it part of?
- 2. What major seas surround Greece? (Hint: Look for the Mediterranean, Aegean, and Ionian Seas).
- 3. Identify Greece's neighboring countries on the mainland.
- 4. Locate the capital city, Athens. Is it on the mainland or an island?
- 5. Zoom in on the Aegean Sea. Notice the huge number of islands! These are the famous Greek Isles. Can you find the islands of Skopelos and Skiathos? These were primary filming locations for the first Mamma Mia movie!
- 6. Observe the terrain of mainland Greece and the islands. What do you notice? (Mountains, coastlines, etc.)

Discussion: Why do you think Greece has historically been a seafaring nation? How might the mountainous terrain affect travel and settlement?

Activity 2: Island Focus - Skopelos (The real 'Kalokairi') (20 mins)

Let's dive deeper into Skopelos, the main inspiration for 'Kalokairi'. Use internet search and map tools to investigate:

- Location: Where is Skopelos located within the Aegean Sea? Which island group does it belong to (the Sporades)?
- Size & Shape: How big is it compared to other islands or mainland Greece? What's its general shape?
- **Terrain:** Is it mostly flat or hilly/mountainous? Describe its coastline (sandy beaches, rocky cliffs?).
- **Climate & Vegetation:** Based on its location, what kind of climate would you expect? What kind of plants/trees might grow there (think pines, olive groves)?
- **Island Life:** How do these geographical features likely influence life for people living on Skopelos? (e.g., importance of fishing/tourism, challenges of transport). Compare this to scenes from Mamma Mia.

Activity 3: Geography, Songs, and Sunshine - The Tourism Link (15 mins)

Mamma Mia showcases Greece's beautiful geography, making many people want to visit. This is

called 'film tourism'.

Discussion Points:

- What specific geographical features shown in the movie make Greece seem like an attractive place for a holiday? (Beaches, clear water, scenery, climate).
- How does tourism, boosted by films like Mamma Mia, impact islands like Skopelos? Think about positives (economy, jobs) and potential negatives (crowding, environmental impact).
- How does the island geography itself support tourism? (Beaches for swimming, harbors for boats, hills for views).

Assessment: Plan Your Mamma Mia Geography Trip! (15 mins)

Imagine you're planning a 5-day trip to Greece inspired by Mamma Mia AND its geography. Create a simple itinerary:

- 1. **Choose Locations:** Select at least two different geographical locations in Greece (e.g., Athens + one island like Skopelos, or two different islands).
- 2. Justify Choices: Explain *why* you chose these places based on their specific geography.
- 3. **Activities:** List one geography-related activity you would do at each location (e.g., hike a coastal trail on Skopelos, visit the Acropolis in Athens situated on a rocky outcrop, take a boat tour around island cliffs).

Alternatively, write a descriptive paragraph about the geography of 'Kalokairi' based on the movie scenes and your research on Skopelos.

Conclusion: Dancing Queen's Geography Recap (5 mins)

Great job exploring Greece! We learned that Greece is a country in Southern Europe with extensive coastline, thousands of islands (like Skopelos!), and a mountainous mainland. Its beautiful geography, showcased in films like Mamma Mia, plays a huge role in its culture and tourism. You are now a geographical 'Super Trouper'!

Optional: Play a favorite Mamma Mia song to celebrate your journey!
