

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to analyze and interpret a basketball-related text, demonstrate comprehension through discussion, and apply critical thinking skills to make connections between the text and real-life situations.

Materials and Prep

- Basketball-related reading material (e.g., an article, a short story, or a biography)
- Pen and paper

Activities

1. Read the basketball-related text carefully, underlining or highlighting important points and unfamiliar words.
2. Write a brief summary of the text, highlighting the main ideas and key details.
