Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to identify and describe various animals in Spanish.

Materials and Prep

- Whiteboard or paper
- Markers or colored pencils
- Printed pictures of animals
- Spanish-English animal flashcards (optional)

No prior knowledge of Spanish is required.

Activities

- 1. Introduce the topic by asking the student about their favorite animals and discussing them in English.
- 2. Show the printed pictures of animals and ask the student to name them in English.
- 3. Write the names of the animals on the whiteboard or paper.
- 4. Explain that you will now learn how to say those animal names in Spanish.
- 5. Go through each animal one by one and teach the Spanish word for it. Show the picture and say the word aloud, encouraging the student to repeat after you.
- 6. Practice pronunciation by playing a game of "Guess the Animal". Describe an animal in Spanish and have the student guess which animal it is.
- 7. Use the flashcards (if available) to reinforce learning. Show a flashcard with an animal picture and ask the student to say the corresponding Spanish word.
- 8. Encourage the student to draw their favorite animal and write its name in Spanish next to it.
- 9. Review all the animal names in Spanish before ending the lesson.

Second Grade Talking Points

- "Animals are living things that can be found all around the world."
- "Different animals live in different habitats, such as forests, oceans, or deserts."
- "Animals have different characteristics, such as fur, feathers, or scales."
- "In Spanish, we can learn how to say the names of animals."
- "Learning new languages helps us communicate with people from different countries."
- "Here are some useful phrases to learn in Spanish: 'Hola' means hello, 'Gracias' means thank you, and 'Por favor' means please."
