Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to write a creative story using Pokemon characters and elements.

Materials and Prep

- Paper
- Pencils or pens
- Pokemon cards or images (optional)

Before starting this lesson, make sure you have a basic understanding of Pokemon characters and their abilities. If needed, you can research or refer to Pokemon resources.

Activities

1. Brainstorming Pokemon Story Ideas:

Think about your favorite Pokemon characters and their abilities. Write down a list of Pokemon characters you want to include in your story.
