## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will understand the basic concepts of government and citizenship through the game Zelda Tears of the Kingdom.

## **Materials and Prep**

- A computer or gaming console with Zelda Tears of the Kingdom
- A notebook or paper for taking notes
- Prior knowledge of the game controls and basic gameplay

## Activities

- 1. Begin by playing Zelda Tears of the Kingdom together. Explore the game world and discuss the different characters and their roles.
- Pause the game and have a discussion about what government is. Ask questions like: "Who is in charge of the kingdom in the game? How do they make decisions? How do they keep the kingdom safe?"
- 3. Resume playing the game and focus on the concept of citizenship. Discuss the responsibilities of the citizens in the game, such as following the laws and helping others.
- 4. Take notes on the different aspects of government and citizenship that you encounter during gameplay.
- 5. After playing, review the notes and have a conversation about what you learned. Ask questions like: "Why is it important to have a government? How can citizens contribute to their community?"

## **Preschool Grade Talking Points**

- "In the game Zelda Tears of the Kingdom, there is a kingdom ruled by a king or queen. They make important decisions to keep the kingdom safe and happy."
- "The citizens in the game are like the people who live in the kingdom. They have to follow the rules and help each other."
- "Government is like a group of people who make decisions for a place. They help keep things fair and make sure everyone is safe."
- "Citizenship means being a good member of your community. It's important to follow the rules and help others when you can."
- "By playing Zelda Tears of the Kingdom, we can learn about how governments work and how we can be good citizens in our own communities."
