

Guinea Pig Reading Adventure!

Materials Needed:

- A simple, age-appropriate book about guinea pigs (or a printed short story/fact sheet)
 - Paper
 - Crayons or colored pencils
 - Pencil
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Let's Get Started!

Hello Super Reader! Today we're going on an adventure to learn all about fuzzy little animals called guinea pigs! Have you ever seen one? They make funny little noises and love to eat yummy vegetables.

Reading Time!

Let's read our guinea pig book (or story) together. We'll take turns reading sentences. I'll help you with any tricky words. Pay attention to what the guinea pigs look like, what they eat, and what sounds they make!

(Teacher and student read the selected text together. Focus on sounding out words and reading smoothly.)

What Did We Learn?

Great reading! Now, let's see what we remember. Can you tell me:

- What color can guinea pigs be?
- What is one food that guinea pigs like to eat?
- What kind of sound does a guinea pig make? (Wheek! Wheek!)
- Are guinea pigs big or small animals?

Fun Activity: Draw and Write!

Now it's your turn to be an artist and writer! Get your paper and crayons.

1. Draw a picture of a guinea pig. What color will yours be? Will it be eating something yummy?
2. Under your picture, let's write a sentence together. How about: "My guinea pig is cute." or "The guinea pig likes carrots." We can sound out the words together!

(Assist the student with drawing details and writing their sentence.)
