

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to greet someone in Spanish and understand some basic phrases.

Materials and Prep

- No materials are required for this lesson.
- No prior knowledge of Spanish is necessary.

Activities

- Activity 1: Greetings Song

We will start by learning a fun greetings song in Spanish. Listen to the song and try to sing along. Pay attention to the words for "hello" and "goodbye".

- Activity 2: Greeting Flashcards

I will show you flashcards with different greetings in Spanish. Repeat after me and practice saying them aloud. We will go through common greetings like "hola" (hello), "adiós" (goodbye), "buenos días" (good morning), "buenas tardes" (good afternoon), and "buenas noches" (good evening).

- Activity 3: Role Play

We will pretend to greet each other in Spanish. I will say a greeting and you can respond with the appropriate response. Let's practice using "hola" and "adiós".

Kindergarten Grade Talking Points

- "In today's lesson, we are going to learn how to greet someone in Spanish."
- "Greeting someone is a polite way to say hello or goodbye."
- "We will learn how to say different greetings like 'hello', 'goodbye', 'good morning', 'good afternoon', and 'good evening' in Spanish."
- "We will practice saying these greetings together and even pretend to greet each other in Spanish."
- "Learning how to greet someone in a different language can be fun and useful when you meet new people."
- "Some useful phrases to learn in Spanish are: '¿Cómo estás?' (How are you?), 'Gracias' (Thank you), and 'Por favor' (Please)."
