## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to identify different types of trees and understand their importance in the environment.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Pictures or illustrations of various trees
- Whiteboard or large paper
- Markers or crayons

## Activities

- 1. Tree Identification Game: Show the pictures or illustrations of different trees and have the student guess the names of the trees. Give them hints if needed.
- 2. Tree Drawing: Ask the student to choose their favorite tree and draw it on the whiteboard or large paper. Encourage them to include details such as leaves, branches, and roots.
- 3. Tree Story: Help the student create a story about a tree. Ask them questions about what the tree looks like, where it grows, and who lives in or around it. Write down the story as they dictate it.
- Tree Hunt: Take a walk outside and look for different types of trees in your neighborhood or local park. Encourage the student to observe the differences in size, shape, and color of the trees.

## **Preschool Grade Talking Points**

- "Trees are big plants that grow tall and have a trunk."
- "Trees have roots that go into the ground to help them stay standing."
- "Leaves are a part of the tree that helps it make food and gives us oxygen to breathe."
- "Different trees have different shapes and colors of leaves."
- "Trees are important because they provide shade, clean the air, and give homes to animals."
