## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to spell words related to villains.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Whiteboard or paper
- Markers or crayons
- Printed pictures of different villains

No prior knowledge is required for this lesson.

## Activities

• Activity 1: Villain Spelling Match

Write the names of different villains on the whiteboard or paper, leaving space for the letters to be filled in. Show the printed pictures of the villains and ask the student to identify each one. Then, together, spell out the name of each villain, focusing on the sounds of the letters and how they come together to form the word.

• Activity 2: Villain Word Search

Create a word search puzzle with words related to villains. Provide the student with the word search and encourage them to find and circle the hidden words. As they find each word, have them spell it out loud and reinforce the correct spelling.

• Activity 3: Create Your Own Villain

Ask the student to imagine and draw their own villain character. Once they have drawn the character, help them write the name of their villain below the drawing. Encourage them to sound out the letters and spell the name to the best of their ability. Provide guidance and support as needed.

## **Kindergarten Grade Talking Points**

- "Today, we are going to have fun with spelling and learn words related to villains!"
- "Villains are characters in stories who often cause trouble or try to do bad things."
- "Can you tell me the names of some famous villains you know?"
- "Let's spell out the names of different villains together. Pay attention to the sounds of the letters and how they come together to form the words."
- "Now, we have a word search puzzle with hidden words related to villains. Can you find and circle the words?"
- "As you find each word, let's spell it out loud together. Remember to listen for the sounds of the letters."
- "Now, let's use our imagination and create our own villain character! Draw a picture of your villain and write their name below the drawing. Try to sound out the letters and spell the name as best as you can."
- "Great job today! You have learned how to spell words related to villains. Keep practicing your spelling skills!"
