

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to read and comprehend a Toy Story book, identify key characters and settings, and discuss the main events of the story.

Materials and Prep

- A Toy Story book or any book related to the movie
- Pen or pencil
- Blank paper

Activities

1. Start by reading the Toy Story book together. Take turns reading pages or paragraphs aloud.
2. After reading, ask questions to check comprehension. For example:
 - Who are the main characters in the story?
 - Where does the story take place?
 - What is the main problem or conflict in the story?
 - How is the problem resolved?
3. Encourage the student to draw their favorite scene or character from the book on the blank paper.
4. Discuss the drawing and ask the student to describe why they chose that particular scene or character.

Second Grade Talking Points

- "In Toy Story, the main characters are toys that come to life when humans are not around."
- "The story takes place in a child's bedroom and various other locations like a pizza restaurant and a toy store."
- "The main problem in the story is that Woody, the main toy, feels jealous and threatened when a new toy named Buzz Lightyear arrives."
- "The problem is resolved when Woody and Buzz work together to save another toy and become friends."
