Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to analyze and comprehend a reading passage about go-karting, and demonstrate their understanding through a creative writing activity.

Materials and Prep

- Reading passage about go-karting
- Paper and pencil for note-taking and writing activity

Activities

- 1. Introduce the topic of go-karting and engage the student by asking them what they know or have heard about go-karting. Write down their responses on the board or a piece of paper.
- 2. Provide the student with the reading passage about go-karting and give them some time to read it silently. Encourage them to underline or highlight important information as they read.
- 3. Discuss the reading passage with the student, asking questions to check their comprehension. Some possible questions could be:
 - What is go-karting?
 - What are the different types of go-karts?
 - What are the safety precautions involved in go-karting?
 - What are some popular go-karting tracks or events?
- 4. After discussing the reading passage, ask the student to write a short creative story or description about their own go-karting experience. Encourage them to include details and use descriptive language to make their story engaging.
- 5. Once the student has finished writing, have them share their story with you or a family member. Provide feedback and praise their efforts.
