Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to identify and analyze the use of grammar in graffiti art.

Materials and Prep

- Pencil and paper
- Internet access (optional)
- Printed examples of graffiti art (optional)

No prior knowledge is required for this lesson.

Activities

- 1. Introduction to Grammar in Graffiti Art: Discuss with the student the connection between language arts and graffiti art. Explain that graffiti artists often use various grammar elements to convey their messages effectively.
- 2. Identifying Grammar Elements: Show the student examples of graffiti art (either printed or through online resources). Ask them to identify any grammar elements they can find, such as nouns, verbs, adjectives, and punctuation marks. Have them write down their observations.

- 5. Share and Discuss: Once the student has completed their artwork, have them present it to you or other family members. Discuss the grammar elements they incorporated and the meaning behind their design choices.
