Introduction: Kapow! Create Your Own Superhero!

- 4. **Personality Traits:** Choose 3 words to describe your hero (e.g., brave, kind, clever, fast, quiet, determined).
- Weakness: What's one thing that challenges your hero or that they aren't good at?
- 6. Costume Design: What colors are their suit? Do they have a symbol or a mask? Describe or draw it!
- 7. **Quick Origin:** Write one sentence about how they became a hero. (e.g., 'A friendly alien gave them a power ring.' or 'They were struck by glowing lightning.')

Draw Your Hero!

Use your crayons or markers to bring your superhero to life! Draw them in their costume, maybe even showing off one of their powers!
