

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to create your own pumpkin patch artwork using basic art materials.

Materials and Prep

- Orange construction paper
- Green construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Black marker
- Pencil

Make sure you have a clear workspace and gather all the materials before starting the lesson.

Activities

1. Draw and cut out a large pumpkin shape from the orange construction paper.
2. Draw and cut out a stem shape from the green construction paper.
3. Glue the stem to the top of the pumpkin shape.
4. Use the black marker to draw a face on the pumpkin. You can make it happy, silly, or scary - it's up to you!
5. Draw and cut out smaller pumpkin shapes from the orange construction paper.
6. Glue the smaller pumpkin shapes around the large pumpkin to create a pumpkin patch.

Kindergarten Grade Talking Points

- "Today, we are going to learn about pumpkin patches and create our own pumpkin patch artwork."
- "Pumpkin patches are places where pumpkins grow. They are usually found on farms."
- "Pumpkins come in different shapes, sizes, and colors. They can be orange, yellow, or even white!"
- "Pumpkin patches are popular in the fall, especially during Halloween and Thanksgiving."
- "We can use our imagination and create our own pumpkin patch artwork using paper and colors."
- "Let's start by drawing and cutting out a big pumpkin shape from the orange construction paper."
- "Now, let's add a stem to our pumpkin using the green construction paper."
- "Next, we can draw a face on our pumpkin to give it some personality."
- "Let's create more pumpkins by drawing and cutting out smaller shapes."
- "Finally, we can glue all the smaller pumpkins around the big pumpkin to make our pumpkin patch!"
