Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to identify and discuss the main characters and themes in Franklin the Turtle stories, and demonstrate comprehension through simple activities.

Materials and Prep

Materials: Franklin the Turtle books (or online stories), paper, crayons or markers.

Prep: Familiarize yourself with Franklin the Turtle stories and prepare a few discussion questions.

Activities

- 1. Read a Franklin the Turtle story together and discuss the main characters and themes.
- 2. Draw a picture of Franklin and his friends, and talk about what they like to do.

3. Act out a short scene from a Franklin the Turtle story, taking turns playing different characters.

Preschool Grade Talking Points

- "Who is Franklin the Turtle? He is a friendly turtle who goes on adventures with his friends."
- "What are some things Franklin likes to do? He likes to play with his friends and learn new things."
- "Why is it important to have friends like Franklin does? Friends help each other and have fun together."
