

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to write your own poetry inspired by Spongebob Squarepants.

## Materials and Prep

- Paper and pencils
- Spongebob Squarepants episodes or clips
- Optional: Spongebob Squarepants books or poems

## Activities

1. Watch a Spongebob Squarepants episode or clip together.

Pay attention to the characters, their personalities, and the humor in the show.

2. Discuss the episode or clip:

- What was your favorite part?
- What did you find funny?
- How would you describe the characters?

3. Brainstorm a list of words or phrases that come to mind when you think of Spongebob Squarepants.

Think about the setting, the characters, and the overall tone of the show.

4. Use your word list to write a poem inspired by Spongebob Squarepants.

Try to incorporate humor and capture the essence of the show in your writing.

5. Share your poem with someone else, or even perform it as a spoken word piece.

Discuss what you enjoyed about the writing process and any challenges you faced.
