3. Prehistoric Proofreading (10 minutes)

Review the sentences you wrote. Check carefully for correct spelling of the vocabulary words and any other words in your sentences. Read them aloud to see if they make sense.

4. Creative Challenge: Dominion Dispatch (20-30 minutes)

Imagine you are a character in the 'Jurassic World: Dominion' universe (a scientist, a park ranger, a journalist, etc.). Write a short journal entry, news report, or descriptive paragraph (about 100-150 words) about a specific event or observation involving dinosaurs living in the modern world. We will review your definitions, sentences, and your creative writing piece together. We'll check for:

- Correct spelling of all list words.
- Accurate definitions.
- Correct usage of vocabulary words in sentences and the creative writing piece.

Finally, we'll have a quick spelling quiz on the 'Jurassic Words' list either orally or written.
