

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to understand the basic history and culture of Ancient Egypt, including the significance of the Nile River, the pyramids, and the pharaohs.

## Materials and Prep

Materials: Paper, pencil, coloring materials (crayons, markers), access to online resources about Ancient Egypt.

Prep: Familiarize yourself with the basics of Ancient Egypt, including the Nile River, pyramids, and pharaohs.

## Activities

- Create a map of Ancient Egypt, including the Nile River, major cities, and landmarks. Label and color the map to show the importance of the Nile River to the civilization.

- "The Egyptians had their own system of writing called hieroglyphics, and they made beautiful art and jewelry."
