

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the Year 7 homeschool student will be able to understand the key aspects of the Roman Empire, its impact on the United Kingdom, and its significance in history.

Materials and Prep

- Internet access
- Pen and paper

No prior knowledge is required for this lesson.

Activities

1. Research: Instruct the student to use the internet to research the Roman Empire. They should focus on its expansion, culture, architecture, and influence on the United Kingdom.
2. Map Exercise: Provide the student with a blank map of the Roman Empire and ask them to label key cities, provinces, and territories. They should also mark the location of the United Kingdom within the empire.
3. Timeline Creation: Ask the student to create a timeline of important events in the history of the Roman Empire. They should include significant dates such as the founding of Rome, the rise of Julius Caesar, the construction of Hadrian's Wall, and the fall of the Western Roman Empire.
4. Discussion: Engage in a discussion with the student about the impact of the Roman Empire on the United Kingdom. Encourage them to share their findings from their research and ask them questions to deepen their understanding.
