

Objective

By the end of this lesson, the homeschool student will be able to utilize library skills to research and explore information about flowers.

Materials and Prep

- Access to a library or online library resources
- Pen and paper for note-taking
- Computer or tablet with internet access (optional)

Activities

1. Introduce the topic of flowers and their significance. Discuss different types of flowers and their characteristics.
