Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand the concepts of environmental science and how they relate to the warrior cats books.

Materials and Prep

- Warrior Cats books (any of your choice)
- Notebook or paper
- Pencil or pen

Activities

- 1. Read a section of the warrior cats book that involves the cats' interaction with their environment. Pay attention to how they adapt and survive.
- 2. Take notes on the environmental elements mentioned in the book (e.g., forests, rivers, mountains, prey). Include details about how the cats rely on these elements for survival.

Talking Points

- **Environmental Science:** Environmental science is the study of how living organisms interact with their environment and the impact of human activities on the natural world.
- Adaptations: Animals, including warrior cats, have specific adaptations that help them survive in their environment. These can include physical characteristics, behaviors, or specialized skills.
- **Ecosystems:** An ecosystem is a community of living organisms (plants, animals, and microorganisms) and their physical environment (air, water, soil) that interact with one another. Warrior cats rely on the ecosystem they inhabit for resources and survival.
- **Human Impact:** Humans can have both positive and negative impacts on the environment. It's important to be aware of our actions and make choices that help protect and preserve the natural world.
