Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand the historical context of warrior cats books and make connections between the fictional world and real historical events.

Materials and Prep

- Warrior Cats books or access to online resources about the series
- Pen and paper for note-taking
- Access to a computer or tablet for research (if needed)

Activities

- 1. Research the author and background of the warrior cats books. Write a short biography of the author and explore any influences or inspirations for the series.
