## **Objective**

By the end of this lesson, the student will have a basic understanding of cosmetology and be able to explore different aspects of the field.

## **Materials and Prep**

- Mirror
- Makeup products (if available)
- Access to the internet for research
- Pen and paper for note-taking

No prior knowledge or preparation is required for this lesson.

## **Activities**

## **Talking Points**

- Makeup Experimentation: "If you have access to makeup products, feel free to experiment with different looks. Follow online tutorials or create your own unique style. Remember to cleanse your face before and after, and be mindful of hygiene."
- **Create a Vision Board:** "Use magazines or printouts to create a vision board showcasing your ideal beauty style. Cut out pictures, write notes, or sketch your ideas. This will help you visualize your goals."
- **Interview a Professional:** "Reach out to a local cosmetologist or hairstylist for a short interview. Ask about their profession, required skills, and their personal journey. It's a great way to gain insights from someone experienced in the field."
