

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have a deeper understanding of Undertale and its themes, as well as develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

## Materials and Prep

- A computer or gaming console with Undertale installed
- Pen and paper for note-taking
- Access to the internet for research (optional)

## Activities

1. Play Undertale: Start by playing Undertale together. Explore the game world, interact with characters, and make choices that affect the outcome.
2. Character Analysis: Choose one character from Undertale and write a character analysis. Describe their personality, motivations, and role in the game.
3. Moral Dilemmas: Discuss the moral dilemmas presented in Undertale. Have the student think about the choices they made during gameplay and reflect on the consequences of those choices.
4. Design Your Own Encounter: Encourage the student to create their own unique encounter in Undertale. They can draw the character, write dialogue, and come up with different choices and outcomes.
