Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have a deeper understanding of Undertale and its themes, as well as develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

Materials and Prep

- A computer or gaming console with Undertale installed
- Pen and paper for note-taking
- Access to the internet for research (optional)

Activities

- 1. Play Undertale: Start by playing Undertale together. Explore the game world, interact with characters, and make choices that affect the outcome.
- 2. Character Analysis: Choose one character from Undertale and write a character analysis. Describe their personality, motivations, and role in the game.
- 3. Moral Dilemmas: Discuss the moral dilemmas presented in Undertale. Have the student think about the choices they made during gameplay and reflect on the consequences of those choices.
- 4. Design Your Own Encounter: Encourage the student to create their own unique encounter in Undertale. They can draw the character, write dialogue, and come up with different choices and outcomes.
