

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand and apply English grammar concepts while creating a vision board.

Materials and Prep

- Poster board or large paper
- Magazines or printed images
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Markers or colored pencils

Prior knowledge required: Basic understanding of English grammar concepts such as nouns, verbs, adjectives, and sentences.

Activities
