Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will have a better understanding of the California Gold Rush through the exploration of historical fiction books.

Materials and Prep

- Historical fiction books about the California Gold Rush
- Writing materials (paper, pencils, pens)
- Computer or tablet with internet access (optional)

Activities

- 1. Book Exploration: Allow the student to choose a historical fiction book about the California Gold Rush that interests them. Encourage them to look for books with engaging characters and exciting plots.
