

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to understand and explain the importance of key battles in World War I.

Materials and Prep

- Pen and paper
- Access to a computer or library for research
- Prior knowledge of the causes and basic timeline of World War I

Activities

1. Create a Battle Timeline:

Using the information you have learned about World War I, create a timeline of the major battles. Include the dates, locations, and brief descriptions of each battle. 2. Research and Present:
