

## Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will have gained a deeper understanding of film studies and mixed media, and be able to apply your knowledge to create your own films or mixed media projects.

## Materials and Prep

- Computer or laptop with internet access
- Pen and paper for note-taking

## Activities
