## **Activities**

### 2. Country Capitals Quiz:

Research the capitals of various countries around the world. Create a quiz with multiple-choice questions for yourself or a friend. Test your knowledge and challenge each other.

### 3. Geographical Landmarks:

Choose five famous geographical landmarks from different continents. Research their locations, historical significance, and unique features. Create a presentation or poster showcasing these landmarks.

# **Talking Points**

#### What is geography?

"Geography is the study of the Earth's physical features, climate, and the distribution of plants, animals, and human populations."

#### Why is geography important?

"Geography helps us understand how humans and the environment interact, how different cultures develop, and how resources are distributed around the world."

#### What are the seven continents?

"The seven continents are Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Europe, North America, Australia, and South America."

### What are the five oceans?

"The five oceans are the Atlantic Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Indian Ocean, Southern Ocean, and Arctic Ocean."

## • Why is it important to know country capitals?

"Knowing country capitals helps us understand the political and administrative centers of different nations. It also aids in communication and cultural understanding."

## • What can we learn from geographical landmarks?

"Geographical landmarks provide insights into a country's history, culture, and natural wonders. They often attract tourists and contribute to a nation's identity."
