

Objective

By the end of this lesson, you will be able to learn and understand new English vocabulary related to the NFL.

Materials and Prep

- A computer or tablet with internet access
- Paper and pencils for writing
- A football or a picture of a football

Activities

- Watch a short video about the NFL and take notes on new words you hear.
- Draw a picture of a football field and label different parts of the field using the new vocabulary words you learned.
- Write a short story or paragraph about your favorite NFL team, using as many new vocabulary words as possible.
- Create flashcards with the new words and their definitions. Practice with a family member or friend.
- Play a game of charades, acting out different NFL-related words or phrases for others to guess.

Talking Points

- "The NFL stands for the National Football League. It is a professional American football league."
- "There are 32 teams in the NFL, and they compete against each other to win the Super Bowl."
- "The positions in football include quarterback, wide receiver, running back, and many more."
- "The football field is divided into two halves, with each team trying to score touchdowns or field goals."
- "Some popular NFL teams are the New England Patriots, Green Bay Packers, and Dallas Cowboys."
- "The Super Bowl is the championship game of the NFL and is watched by millions of people."
- "The NFL has a lot of exciting plays like interceptions, touchdowns, and long passes."

- "Football players wear helmets, shoulder pads, and other protective gear to stay safe while playing."
