Objective

By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to:

- Create an animal-themed artwork using various materials
- Identify and pronounce phonetic sounds of different animals
- Perform basic gymnastics and martial art movements
- Learn about Greek history through storytelling
- Explore space and learn about the solar system
- Engage in STEM activities related to addition and subtraction

Materials and Prep

- Art supplies (paper, crayons, markers, glue, scissors)
- Animal picture cards or books
- Gymnastics mat or soft surface
- Space-themed books or resources
- Counting objects (e.g., blocks, buttons)

No specific prior knowledge is required.

Activities

- Create an Animal Collage: Provide the student with various materials and encourage them to create a collage of their favorite animals using cut-outs, drawings, and other art supplies.
- Phonics Animal Match: Show the student picture cards of different animals and ask them to identify the animal and make the corresponding phonetic sound.
- Gymnastics and Martial Art Moves: Teach the student basic gymnastics movements like forward rolls and balancing, as well as simple martial art poses and kicks.
- Storytelling: Introduce the student to Greek history through storytelling, focusing on popular myths and legends involving animals.
- Space Exploration: Explore books or online resources about space and the solar system, discussing different planets, stars, and astronauts.
- STEM Math Activities: Engage the student in hands-on activities involving addition and subtraction, such as counting objects and solving simple math problems using manipulatives.

Talking Points

- "Let's use our imagination and create a beautiful artwork with animals. What animals do you like the most? Let's use these colors to make them come alive!"
- "Look at this picture card! Can you tell me what animal it is? Great job! Now, can you make the sound that animal makes? Very good!"
- "Now it's time to be active and learn some gymnastics and martial art moves. Let's start with a forward roll. Ready, set, go! Roll forward like a ball!"
- "Did you know that long ago, there were powerful Greek gods and goddesses who could turn into animals? Let me tell you a story about one of them!"
- "Space is so fascinating! There are many planets and stars out there. Let's pretend we are
